DIRECTIVE IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 AND 21-DAY LOCKDOWN

- On 23 March 2020, the President Mr Cyril Ramaphosa, announced that the National Coronavirus Command Council has decided to enforce a nation-wide lockdown for 21 days with effect from midnight on Thursday 26 March 2020.
- 2. This is in response to the evolving outbreak in South Africa of the Coronavirus, otherwise known as COVID-19, which has been declared by the World Health Organisation (WHO) to be a global pandemic.
- 3. In issuing of this directive, the CSOS has had regard to the following instruments or directives:
 - The directive issued by the President of the Republic of South Africa, Mr. Cyril Ramaphosa;
 - The declaration of a national state of disaster, in terms of section 27(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 issued by the Minister of Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs, Dr Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma, and published on 15 March 2020 in Government Gazette No. 43096.

4. The CSOS hereby directs as follows:

4.1 All contact processes such as conciliation, adjudication and investigation are suspended until Friday 17 April 2020.

- 4.2 All matters set down for the period, as noted in point 4.1 above, are postponed until the country shutdown is suspended.
- 4.3 The CSOS Service to the public will resume on Monday, 20 April 2020.
- 4.4 No person will be allowed to walk into any of the CSOS offices.
- 4.5 The CSOS will not accept enquiries or attend to matters during this time.
